

Bidding on OASIS+ - The Basics



- OASIS+ is expected to have ~\$130 billion in awards, more than double the current OASIS contract (~\$60 billion)
- OASIS+ has transitioned to GSA eBuy as the OASIS+ task order solicitation platform
- Ordering Contracting Officers (OCOs) can place orders about 7 to 10 days after Master Contract awards are issued


Bidding on OASIS+ - Overlap with OASIS



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
Transition from Symphony to GSA eBuy


- The OASIS+ has transitioned from Symphony to GSA eBuy for task order solicitations
- Need to create profile and be assigned to your vendor entity in GSA eBuy
- Can search eBuy by Master Contract number for opportunities























Government Functions of GSA eBuy



- Review vendor information and core capabilities
- Create and release Requests for Information (RFIs), and conduct market research
- Create and release Requests for Quotation (RFQs)
- Conduct Questions and Answers
- Release RFQ amendments
- Receive vendor proposals
- Report award information



What is the scope of OASIS+ Task Order Solicitations?

Allowed

- FFP, T&M, LH, Cost, Hybrid
- CONUS or OCONUS
- Commercial or non-commercial
- Service Contract Labor Standards
- Options and various CLIN structure
- Non-classified and Classified*

Not Allowed

- IDIQs or BPAs
- Inherently governmental functions
- FAR Part 36 (Construction and Architect-Engineer Contracts)
- Efforts under NAICS codes other than listed under domain
- Information Technology

Task Order Solicitation Release

- Released by Master Contract, Domain, and NAICS i.e.
 Women Owned Small Business (WOSB), Management and Advisory, NAICS 541611
- Must be solicited by an OCO with a Delegation of Procurement Authority (DPA)
- Cannot further set aside but can limit fair opportunity based on FAR 16.505(b)(2)
- Solicited in accordance with FAR 16.505 Ordering

Benefits of 16.505 Procedures:

- ✓ No minimum solicitation period
- √ Synopsys not required
- ✓ Formal Source Selection Evaluation Board (SSEB) not required
- ✓ Do not need to conduct discussions

What to know about OASIS+ Task Order Solicitations?

- May require a re-representation of size status
- Response times are agency and OCO specific
- Task Orders can be up to five years and six months after the Master Contract expires
- It is encouraged that Task Order Solicitations
 will include the standardized labor categories
- Will include Agency specific clauses

1.0 OASIS+ TASK ORDER INFORMATION

- 1.1. OASIS+ Domain and Master Contract CLIN Being Solicited/Awarded: [Insert the Domain Name and CLIN]
- **1.2.** NAICS Code and Small Business Size Standard: The principal nature of the requirements described in this solicitation is consistent with services performed by industries in the [Insert the NAICS code and title] with a small business size standard of [Insert small business size standard]
- **1.3.** Product Service Code (PSC): The services in this solicitation are best represented by PSC [Insert the applicable PSC code and title (see PSC Manual.)]
- 1.4. Type of Contract: The primary type of contract resulting from this solicitation is: [Insert the predominant contract type (Cost Plus Fixed Fee, Firm Fixed Price, Time and Materials, etc.)

- 1.6. Extent of Competition: [Check the box that applies]
 - ____ Fair opportunity procedures (FAR 16.505(b)(1))
 - Exception to fair opportunity procedures as designated below (FAR 16.505(b)(2))


 [Check only one exception below]
 - FAR 16.505(b)(2)(A) The agency's need for the supplies or services is so urgent that providing a fair opportunity would result in unacceptable delays.
 - <u>FAR 16.505(b)(2)(B)</u> Only one awardee is capable of providing the supplies or services required at the level of quality required because the supplies or services ordered are unique or highly specialized.

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Pricing OASIS+ Proposals

- Prices are determined fair and reasonable at the Task Order level
- The ceiling rates are established for non-custom, CONUS, T&M labor when there is **not adequate price competition.** There are no ceiling rates if there is competition:
 - FAR 52.216-29 or DFARs 252.216-7002 or FAR 52.216-31
- Escalation factor for future ceiling rates is based on the average Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) Employment Cost Index (ECI) data for the previous 3 years
- OASIS+ Contract Access Fee (CAF) remitted by the Vendor, it is currently 0.15% and applied to total cost (including travel, profit, labor, etc.) and must be a separate line item.

Other Proposal Considerations

- Any source selections methods may be used to include Best Value Trade Off (BVTO) or Lowest Priced Technically Acceptable (LPTA)
- Streamlined procedures are encouraged, including oral presentations, to reduce cost and time for both the government and vendors
- OCO has broad discretion for which evaluation factors to include (i.e. past performance, price, technical, management) and scoring system
- Task orders will include specific terms and conditions
 - Note: Master Contract terms and conditions take precedence

Marketing Your OASIS+ Master Contract

- Create brochures to include OASIS+ as a solution
- Recommend OASIS+ as a solution via sources sought or RFIs on SAM.gov
- Network by reviewing published contractor list on GSA eBuy
 - Current awardee list is on SAM.gov


